Quick start

KEY FEATURES

- Seamless multiple file uploads in Flash
- Destination folder: Specify default upload directory (@uploadMode = "Simple") or let the user choose it (@uploadMode = "Rich")
- Built in usability features and logic
- Automatic detection of your web server's max upload filesize

PLEASE NOTE

You will need Flash 8 and PHP. Your web server must be configured to accept file uploads. File size limit per file: 100 MB (Flash restriction)

What you can do with it

Flash 8 has built in capabilities (classes) to upload files from your local hard disk to a web server. fileUpload uses these new classes and provides you an easy to use implementation for your own (Flash) projects.

To do

Create an instance of fileUpload:

```
var uploadWindow = new FileUpload(timeline, windowTitle, uploadMode,
                                   xCoord, yCoord, uploadDir, pathUploadScript,
                                   xmlFileStructure);
```

Params

@timeline:MovieClip
attach window to this timeline

@windowTitle:String
title displayed in window title bar

@uploadMode:String
"Simple" or "Rich"

@xCoord:Number
x position to attach window

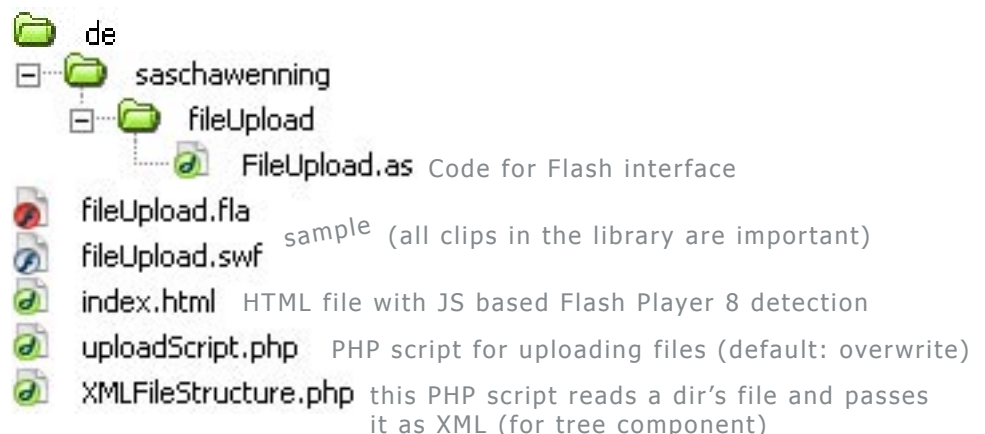
@yCoord:Number
y position to attach window

@uploadDir:String
default upload dir (if uploadMode is set to „Simple“ this is the server's upload directory)

@pathUploadScript:String
relative or absolute path to "uploadScript.php" (String)

@xmlFileStructure:String
relative or absolute path to "XMLFileStructure.php"
(XMLFileStructure.php parses your web servers directory as XML)

NOTES

- Keep in mind that you can customize each file/script to fit your needs.

- Set file permissions to your web server's upload directories (chmod 777)
