File main features

- 1 – Calendar driven portfolio;
- 2 – Supports images, flv video and swf's on the portfolio section;
- 3 – Complete FLV player included;
- 4 – Detects external files size and characteristics and adapts content (border, video controls, load info, etc)
- 5 – MP3 player included;
- 6 – About us and services files included with content driven by XML or static. Dynamic scrollbar included;
- 7 – Contact file/form included (requires PHP on your web server);
- 8 – Drag and drop all content to your server and you are ready to go. All necessary HTML and embedding files are provided;

How to use this file

This is mainly a XML driven template so you will need some knowledge on this area. Basically there are two external XML files that control the template content. These files and their respective structure are:

1. info.xml
 - a) Provides info on the about us and services section and also the music available.
 - b) Structure - Divided in items representing the areas available. For about us and services use the Childnode content with CDATA so that you text is displayed like HTML if necessary. Concerning the music player each

Childnode represents a music track available and you must indicate it's path (attribute named path) and name (attribute named track_name).

2. portfolio.xml

- a) Provides info on the events that will be available on the calendar.
- b) Structure: Divided in year, then months, then days and finally each event info. Here's a sample to create an event on 15 of June of 2008:

This will create an event named Studio MX-a for Racimer client with thumb_1.jpg and that Lorem ipsum description. Also there will be two items available (the image sample.jpg and the video sample.flv)

About DAY fields:

- value - your event day number
- pro_title - your event title
- pro_client - your event client
- pro_thumb - your event thumb
- pro_type - your event type
- description - your event description text

IMAGE fields(One line = one item, Two lines = two items, ...):

- path - your image/flv/swf file path

Some basic information about this file:

1 - It requires MC Tween that you can get at <http://hosted.zeh.com.br/mctween/downloads.html>.

2 - On the 'CONFIGS' layer you can edit the main options:

- var months – An array with the month names that will be displayed
- var days - An array with the number of days in each month
- color_on – Variable that will correspond to the active color
- calendar_vertical_displacement - Variable to control calendar y position
- calendar_but_hor_spacing - Variable to control calendar button horizontal spacing

calendar_but_vert_spacing - Variable to control calendar button vertical spacing
item_max_width=792 - Videos maximum width (Larger will be proportionally scaled)
item_max_height=452 - Videos maximum height (Larger will be proportionally scaled)
items_path="items/" - Path to the portfolio items
thumbs_path="items/min/" - Path to the portfolio thumbs

3 - On the 'music' layer you have all functions related with the MP3 player

4 - On the 'actions' layer you have all main functions

5 – Video functions are On the 'actions' layer of mov_works

6 – About us and services external files are very similar and include some masking transitions and a dynamic scrollbar

7 – Contact external file includes a complete email form. It requires a web server with PHP

8 - Code is fully commented so dig in there if you need to see how it works

9 - Feel free to make adjustments to the code and to e-mail me with any question
